Contact the Traineeship Coordinator, Kylie Freeman, to arrange your initial meeting (details provided below). Alternatively, download the Expression of Interest (EOI) form from www.stanleycollege.edu.au/downloads/ and return to via email to the Traineeship Coordinator.



The Traineeship Coordinator will arrange to visit the employer with the Australian Apprenticeship Support Network (AASN) provider, to sign the training agreement.



Once the training contract is finalised by the Apprenticeship Office, training can commence.
